

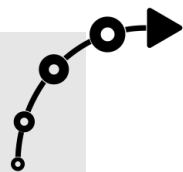

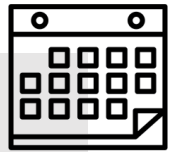

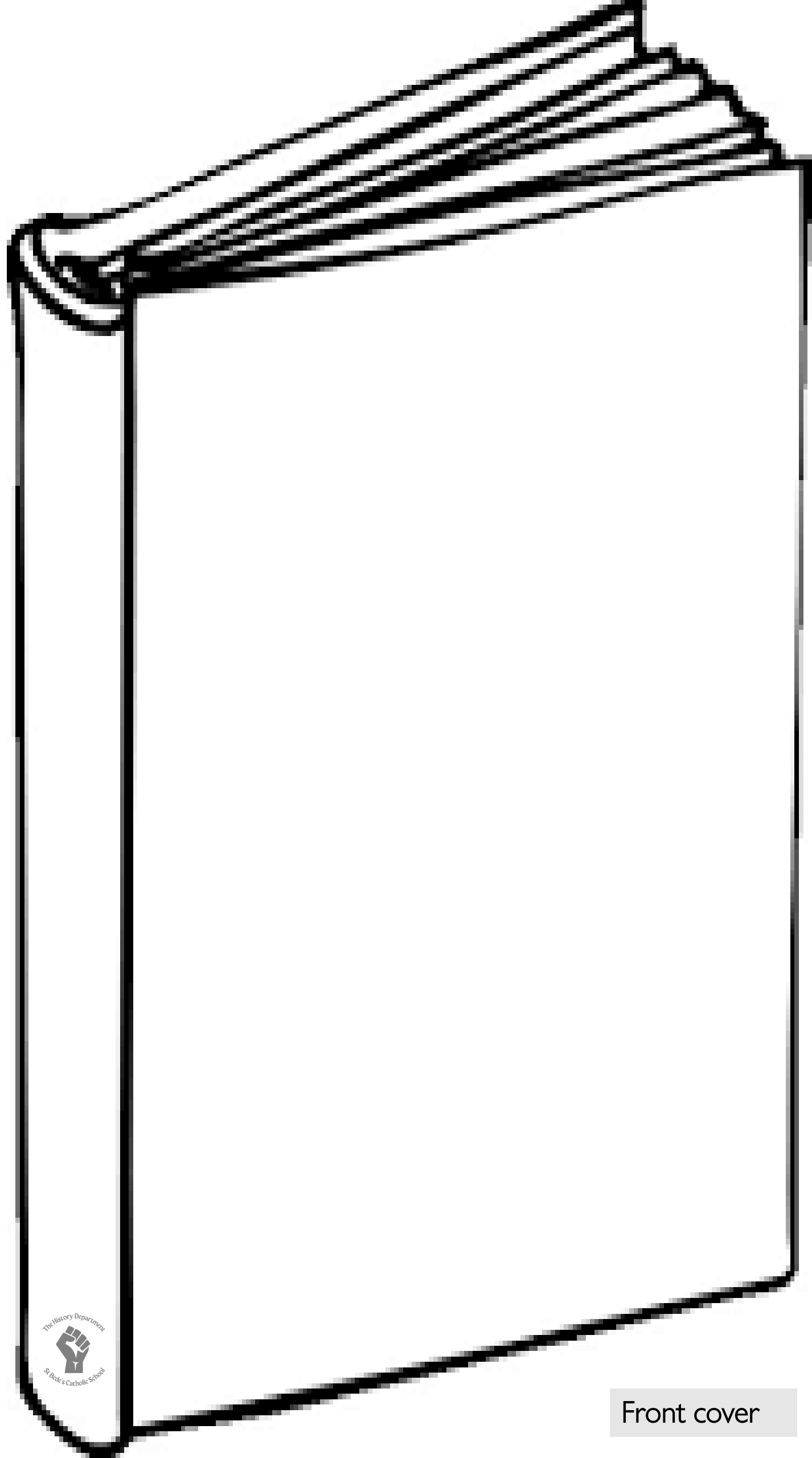


Imagine you are writing a book about one of the events above. What would your front cover look like and what would your blurb be?
