

I believe that by using my gifts and talents, I can strive for **excellence** in all that I do and **inspire** others along the way.



Our Pastoral System



When starting at St Bede's, each student is allocated to a Tutor Group within a Year.

The tutor oversees a child's welfare and development in school, normally remaining with their group from Year 7 to Year 11.


Year Leaders will also remain with their year cohort from Year 7 through to Year 11.


The Tutor Groups meet together every morning for 30 minutes.

The pastoral system is designed so that all students will have a genuine sense of belonging inside this large community.







Prizes and certificates are awarded at the end of term for the highest totals.


A clear School Behaviour Policy is used to deal with behaviour which is unacceptable in school.

All staff are trained and skilled in supporting your child, to listen, understand and act upon any concerns they may have.







Our Transition Team liaises with all new pupils before they start at St Bede's.


In the summer term parents of pupils transferring the following September, together with their children, are invited to St Bede's to meet the Head Teacher, Senior Staff and Pastoral Staff.






