I belong to a community that is **inclusive** and has **Christ** at the heart of all that we do and say.

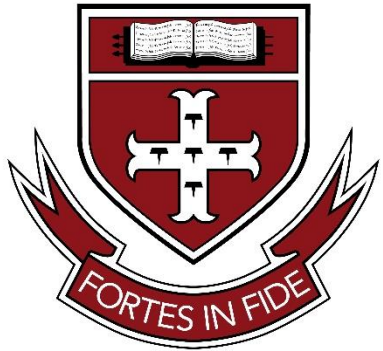
I believe that it is my mission to make Christ known to others.

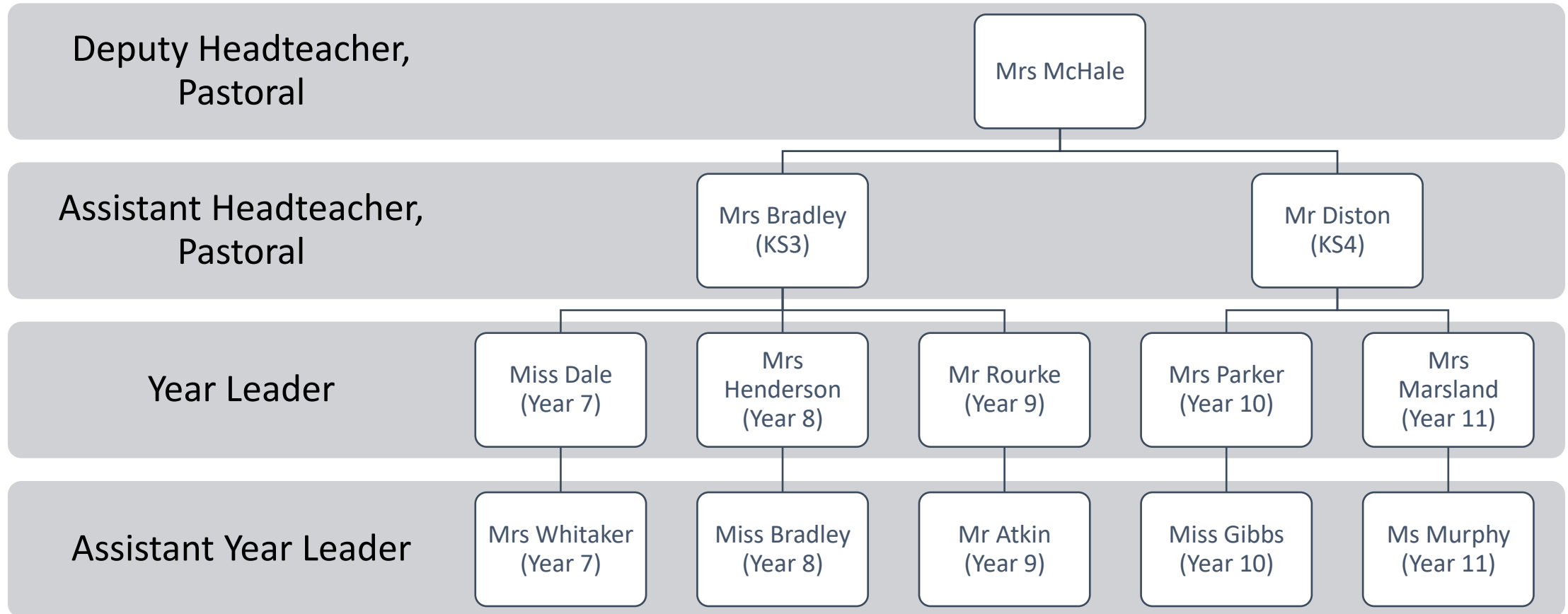
