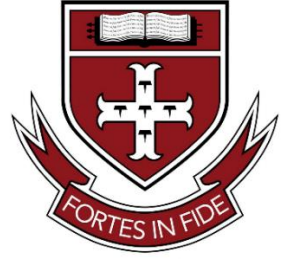


ST BEDE'S SIXTH FORM

16-19 BURSARY FUND



Financial support is available in Sixth Form via 16-19 Bursary Fund.

Eligibility criteria apply:

- 1) A student must be aged 16 or over but under 19 on 31 August at the beginning of the academic year

Students 19 or over must either be continuing a study programme they began aged 16 to 18, or have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)

- 2) Application for support can be made for students from the following defined groups –
 - Looked after (in care)
 - Care leaver
 - In receipt of income support (student)
 - Disabled and in receipt of Employment Support Allowance and Disability Living Allowance/PIP (student)
 - Eligible for Free School Meals during your Sixth Form years
 - Totally family income is equal to or less than £25,000 (including benefits). Proof of income will be requested.

Support is available under the following categories:

- Cost of bus pass used to travel to and from sixth form
- Cost of train/coach travel to attend university interviews and/or open days
- Cost of clothing to adhere to the Sixth Form dress code
- Any costs incurred for work experience/field trips linked to your studies
- Any specialist equipment required for school (related to your studies) such as books or stationary equipment
- Any specific IT needs related to your studies

Claims can be made throughout the year as costs occur. These will either be purchased on your behalf where possible, through the Finance Office or you will be reimbursed, once receipts are provided, via BACS transfer using the details provided on your application form.
